It appears that there are two subspecies to be found here. This can be explained back to the time when there was a sea route from the Indian Ocean to the Gulf of Siam. Ssp. *E. c. godartii* was found to the north, *E. c. graminifera* to the south. Since this route dried up, the subspecies have converged. Intermediate forms are also to be found.

This is not an uncommon butterfly, and can be found in and around gardens and secondary growth. Ssp. *E.c.* godartii is the commoner of the two.

## Range

Sri Lanka, India, Indo-China to S-E China. Also, the Malay Peninsular, along the Archipelago to New Guinea, Australia and the Bismark Islands. However, it is strangely absent from Borneo and the Moluccas.
