# Distant 1886 - Silver Forget-me-not

Very similar to C. strabo, but the underside forerwing has a costal spot closer to the postdiscal band than the cell-end spot.

A common species of secondary vegetation. It is a skittish butterfly and rarely stays settled on any perch for long.
