Grose-Smith 1887 - Broad-banded Oakblue

A medium sized tailless species, which, unlike the majority of *Arhopalas*, seems to prefer secondary vegetation to full forest.

It is very local on the Island, and many can bee seen on a single tree, whilst completely ignoring other trees of the same species nearby.
