Larval Foodplant

Senna alata (Caesalpiaceae), *Ceiba pentandra* (Bombacaceae), *Cinnamomum verum*, *Cinnamomum zeylanicum* (both Lauraceae), *Dimocarpus longan* (Sapindaceae), *Sandoricum indicum* (Meliaceae) and *Ziziphus jujuba* (Rhamnaceae)

Range

Peninsular Thailand, Malaysia, Sumatra and Borneo. Many other [subspecies](#) found From Nepal, Sikkim, Myanmar, Vietnam and Northern Thailand, through to New Guinea.
