

Koh Samui only.

It is not clear whether this species is a resident or an accidental migrant to the Island. It has usually been found after prolonged periods of high winds, which suggests the latter. However, when seen, it can be found in some numbers, which suggests that it may be multi, if not continually, brooded here. The early stages have not been found here.

It is usually to be found away from forests, sometimes in grassland, sometimes in secondary vegetation.
