### Lesson 1837 - The Common Wanderer

Koh Samui and Koh Pha Ngan.

This is a common species found at the edges of forests.

The female is found in two forms, the normal form (*f. anais*), and the rarer *f. lutea*, which has yellow dusting on the basal area of the upperside hindwing.
