### C & R Felder 1865 - The Brown King Crow

Koh Samui only.

A rare species which is getting to the southernmost limits of its range. Very similar to *Euploea eunice*, but it lacks the blue sheen on the forewings of the latter.

This species is found on the edge of forests and in nearby secondary vegetation.
