C. & R. Felder 1860 - White-Banded Awl

This is probably the most common species of this Genus on Samui. It is a denizen of dense forest.

This species was previously known as *H. taminatus malayana*, but, as its range overlapped that of another subspecies, *H. taminatus bhavara*, which is not allowed under the rules of sympatry, it has now been given specific status.
