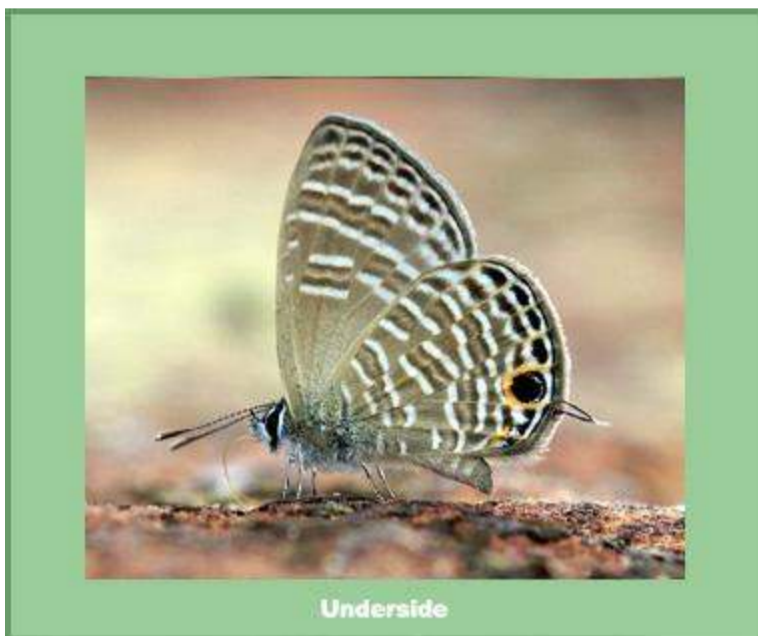

Larval Foodplant

The Singapore subspecies has been bred on *Derris trifoliata*, *Andira inermis* (both Leguminosae) and *Allophylus cobbe* (Sapindaceae)
