This species can be recognised as the underside markings are clearly visible from the upperside. Unfortunately, this does not help in the field.

Flowers of *Embelia subcoriacea* (Myrsinaceae), *Nephelium lappaceum* (Sapindaceae) and *Waltheria indica* (Sterculiaceae)

Peninsular Thailand, Malaysia and Singapore. Other subspecies from Sikkim, Nepal, Myanmar, Indo-China and Northern Thailand.
