Dioscorea hispida, *Dioscorea pentaphylla* (both Dioscoreaceae), *Smilax corbularia* and *Smilax perfoliata* (both Smilacaceae)

Himalayas, Assam, Myanmar and Thailand through to the northern half of the peninsular. Other subspecies in the Southern Peninsular, Malaysia and Singapore.
