### Moore 1858 - The Common Cornelian

This is a fast flying, medium sized butterfly. The upperside of the male is orange-red in colour, whilst the females are less bright, more brownish.

It is usually to be found just outside the limits of forested regions, in secondary vegetation and orchards.

### Larval Foodplant

Flowers, and inside the fruits of *Aesculus indicus* (Hippocastanaceae), *Punica granatum* (Punicaceae), *Dimocarpus longan*, *Litchi chinensis* and *Nephelium lappaceum* (all Sapindaceae)

### Range

Thailand, Malaysia, Sikkim, Myanmar and Indo-China.
