A very rare species on Samui (though frequently encountered on the mainland), which appears to be single brooded, a rare phenomenon for butterflies in the tropics. There is a very similar species found on the mainland, further north, *P. nomius*, where the main distinguishing mark is that on the forewing, the thin pale submarginal line has the last spot but one from the top slightly dislocated out.
